

## **I. Introduction**

The Student Immigration Relief Clinic at Berkeley has five events planned for the month of April: (1) ASUC funding request meeting, (2) an immigration form training & club officer elections, (3) immigration workshop #3, (4) immigration workshop #5, and (5) a joint event with Berkeley Law's International Human Right's Clinic.

## **II. ASUC Funding Request Meeting**

On March 19, 2018, interns Alondra and Nicole met with the ASUC finance committee to discuss future funding for the club. The Clinic only requested for gas reimbursements and an advertisement budget. The next monthly update will provide more details on the outcomes and final budget allocation for the 2018-2019 academic year.

## **III. Form Training & Elections**

On Friday, April 6, 2018, the Student Immigration Relief Clinic at Berkeley will be hosting a brief immigration form training in Barrows 60, from 6-7:00PM. These trainings either serve a mandatory initial training for people who wish to become involved in the immigration clinic, or serve as a refresher for those who have already been trained, but may not fully remember all the components of the immigration forms. The participants of the clinic will be able to see a copy of the immigration documentation and have a chance to practice filling out the form themselves.

The same day, from 7:00-7:30PM, the Clinic will host club officer elections for the positions of director and assistant director. To run, students must attend at least 1 clinic and must have completed the immigration documentation before. Additionally, the people who intend to run must submit an intent to run prior to the meeting. The statement/prompts will be released the weekend of March 23, 2018. The statement will detail: the individual's involvement in the

organization, the individual's plans for future growth of the club, the individual's availability and commitment level to the organization. Other club positions such as graphics, treasurer, and secretary will be interviewed and appointed at a later date.

#### **IV. Immigration Clinic 3 & 4**

On both April 21<sup>st</sup> and April 28<sup>th</sup>, from 7AM-5PM, the Clinic will hold the final two immigration workshops of the year. These will cater to hundreds of clients and the clinic anticipates bringing over 20 volunteers to each clinic. Drivers and language speakers will be prioritized (Spanish, Chinese, Tagalog, and Vietnamese, among others).
